TICKETS

Have you ordered your Recital Tickets? Act fast - if you have not already done so, please secure your tickets now, before additional seats open up for purchase. Make sure your family doesn't miss out by placing your original ticket order promptly:

- Go to the TutuTix website - scan QR code to the right.
- Choose your dancer's Recital ****Be sure to TRIPLE CHECK** that you are ordering tickets for the correct DAY AND TIME. There are a total of 7 Recitals, some on the same day.
- Choose your seats - up to 6 tickets per family (not per dancer), per show. Any additional tickets purchased will be automatically canceled.

- Check March Recital Note or our website for your specific date/time.
- Dancers should arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of their show.
- WDC Recitals are typically 2 - 2 1/2 hours in length.

Dress Rehearsal: Each class has a scheduled dress rehearsal date/time which will be held at our second location, WDC West. At the dress rehearsal, each class will have the opportunity to run through each routine **in costume**. Video-taping is allowed at the dress rehearsal. **All dancers should arrive in full costume.** Classes with more than one costume will be notified of which to wear first. Make-up is optional, but hair accessories should be worn to make sure they stay secure while your dancer is performing. ****Due to space constraints, dancers may have one parent/guardian at Dress Rehearsal.**

Hair and make-up: Dancers are not required to wear their hair a certain way for the recital but should have it pulled back away from the face in a way that compliments the costume and any hairpiece included with the costume. Check out our curly hair wraps in the boutique for a quick but polished updo! Dancers should wear eye shadow, blush and lipstick for their recital please. This will prevent them from being washed out by the stage lights. Mascara is optional but recommended especially for the older dancers. Jewelry should not be worn with the exception of small earrings, if needed. Large dangling earrings, bracelets and necklaces can be a distraction during the performance. Please also remove temporary tattoos and nail polish prior to recital.

Undergarments: Dancers should not wear undergarments that are visible when wearing their costume. Dancers needing to wear a bra should be sure to wear a style that does not have straps that show (unless the straps are clear).
